in the 6th Congressional District. The delivery run ended with a visit to the Clemens Market in the Suburbia Shopping Center on Route 100 in North Coventry.




At the grocery store, Congressman Gerlach met with the employees at the UPS store there and also with Clemens Markets CEO Jack Clemens.
