Dear Mr. Robertson:

We recently learned that TYCO has decided to close its facilities in Exeter Township, Pennsylvania and East Berlin, Pennsylvania and we are writing to request that the company reconsider this decision.

Your decision to close these facilities will affect nearly 750 Pennsylvania working families. It is short-sighted to believe that a foreign workforce or a facility in Mexico or Asia can offer more than what the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has to offer. These Pennsylvania workers undoubtedly have far greater expertise, training and experience than the workforce you will have access to in Mexico or Asia.

We would appreciate an opportunity to meet with you to discuss your restructuring. We would also be willing to help facilitate discussions with state and local officials and economic development agencies in Berks, Adams, and York Counties in order to convince you to reconsider. We also request a meeting to discuss benefits and severance packages being offered to affected workers.
